

Color Wheel Vocabulary & Verse:

Genesis 9:13 ESV “I have set my bow in the cloud, and it shall be a sign of the covenant between me and the earth.”

Hue- The quality of color that is seen as its redness, blueness, etc.
(note: hue is often called the name of a color)

Value- The quality of color that is its lightness or darkness

Intensity-The degree of brightness or dullness of a color

Temperature of a color refers to its warmth or coolness

Tint- Hue plus white

Tone- Hue plus grey

Shade- Hue plus black

Primary Colors- Red, yellow, and blue; these three colors, when mixed, create all other colors

Secondary Colors- Colors created when mixing any two primary colors

Intermediate Colors- Colors created when mixing any two secondary colors (always state the primary color first)

Complementary- Colors opposite each other on the color wheel

Split-Complement- Colors adjacent to one of the complements

Analogous- Colors side by side on the color wheel

Triad- Any three colors on the color wheel that are an equal distance apart

Array- An arrangements of objects in a regular pattern

Axis- A line about which a solid figure rotates

Rotation- A movement of a figure around a fixed point, or axis

Perimeter- The distance around a closed, two-dimensional shape

Sector- A wedge

Diameter- The distance across a circle at its widest point, passing through the axis
